Through the Telepsychiatry Service, Dokotela provides access to free psychiatry consultations for people who:

- Experience mental illness
- Live within the Blue Mountains, Hawkesbury, Lithgow or Penrith regions
- Hold a Centrelink issued healthcare card, family healthcare card or pension card
- Are not currently engaged with public psychiatry services

The service is delivered via video conference from:

- Your practice. MBS incentive items available for practice nurses to facilitate appointments
- The office of a support service that your patient is engaged with
- Your patient, or a support persons home

Phone referral can be made to NBMPHN intake on **1800 223 365**. You will then be required to submit the patients' referral, along with their individual referral code direct to Dokotela.
