# My Health Record Incentive Program for Pharmacists

Nepean Blue Mountains Primary Health Network (NBMPHN) is encouraging Pharmacists to view a patient's My Health Record before dispensing medications, particularly for those patients with multiple medications and chronic diseases.

My Health Record now includes recent medications dispensed from any pharmacy as well as the patient's diagnosis profile to prevent the possibility of incorrect dispensing.

## Every time you view the contents of a patient's My Health Record, you are on your way to winning a prize.

But you'll need to be quick – there are a limited number of prizes. Targets must be commenced and completed in the same calendar month.

The My Health Record incentive program has three levels:

## How to Win
